

PARTIAL EXEMPTIONS

POLI.design scrl provides this regulation for allocating 3 partial exemptions of 25% for candidates who apply for the 2nd edition of the Master's degree in FIBER DESIGN AND TEXTILE PROCESSES.

HOW TO REQUEST PARTIAL EXEMPTION

To request partial exemption, the candidate must submit the admission application to the Master's degree within the deadlines set by the present regulations and submit a formal written request for partial exemption to the following address: formazione@polidesign.net no later than 30/04/2019 23.59 hours (GMT + 1 - Italian time zone).

Partial exemptions can only be used by those who submit the application for selection and participation in the Master's degree "FIBER DESIGN AND TEXTILE PROCESSES" level, year 2019/2020 Decree Index no. 1572 Prot. no. 24257 Date 25.02.2019
Title III Class V UOR SOFPL

The application must be sent within the deadlines indicated and after careful consideration of the requirements indicated in art. 5 of the Rectoral Decree, failing this, the request cannot be accepted.

NECESSARY REQUIREMENTS

Requests for partial exemption will be evaluated by the Master's Course Commission:

- On the basis of possession of the requisites required by Art. 5 of the Decree Index no. 1572 Prot. no. 24257 Date 25.02.2019
- Title III Class V UOR SOFPL



On the basis of the selection interview (also online) with the Scientific
Director of the Master's Degree or a member of the Master's Course
Commission, to which candidates who meet the requisites will be invited.

Candidates will be selected on the basis of how consistent their profile appears to be with the objectives of the Master's degree when their admission application (professional and academic curriculum) is analysed and during the selection interview (also online).

In evaluating candidates and assigning partial exemptions, the Master's administration will consider:

- How consistent the candidate's profile is with the contents of the Master's Degree (40% weighting);
- Professional experiences (30% weighting);
- Motivation for professional development (30% weighting);

The score will be expressed on a scale of 1 to 5 points, all candidates with a selection score of more than 360/500 points will be eligible for partial exemption. The minimum threshold to be eligible for the Master's Degree is 300/500.

If two candidates have the same score, partial exemption will be assigned to the younger candidate.

Candidates who receive a score of less than 360 points and more than 300 points may, if they are eligible for the Master's Degree, proceed to formalise their enrolment even before the date of 30/04/2019.

To apply for selection to the Master's Degree, the following documentation must be sent to the email address: formazione@polidesign.net:

- Application form for admission to the Master's Degree (can be downloaded from http://polidesign.net);
- Curriculum Vitae;
- Portfolio if applicable;
- Self-certification relating to personal identity (name and surname, date and place of birth, nationality and residence);
- · Copy of valid passport or identity document;



• Photocopy of the academic qualification obtained in addition to a certificate showing the grades reported in the individual exams or Diploma Supplement;

MASTER'S COURSE COMMISSION AND SELECTION

The candidacies will be evaluated by the Master's Course Commission indicated in Art. 1 "Characteristics of the Master's Degree" of the Decree Index no. 1572 Prot. no. 24257 Date 25.02.2019 Title III Class V UOR SOFPL

Evaluations will take place at the discretion of the Master's Course Committee.

INCOMPATIBILITIES

Partial exemption cannot be combined with other scholarships, exemptions, prizes or other financial aid for participating in this Master's programme.

DEADLINES FOR INFORMING CANDIDATES OF PARTIAL EXEMPTIONS

Candidates will be selected chronologically in the order applications are received, until all places have been filled.

Partial exemptions will be assigned during the selection and admission process to the Master's Degree, and never after the date on which teaching starts.

The deadline for requesting partial exemption is 30/04/2019 at 23.59 (GMT +1 - Italian time zone).

The beneficiaries of partial exemption only will be informed in writing by 10 May 2019

Beneficiaries of partial exemption must formalise their acceptance and enrolment on the Master's Degree by paying the deposit as provided for in the Private Contract, no later than 24 May 2019, failing to do so will result in immediate forfeiture of the partial exemption.

Enrolment on the Master's Degree is deemed formalised when the deposit has been paid to POLI.design and the private contract has been signed.

The initiative is valid until 30/04/2019 at 23.59 (GMT +1 - Italian time zone).



POLI.design reserves the right not to run the Master's degree, in the event that there is an inadequate number of enrolments, or

in the event that the necessary educational, logistical and administrative support requirements are not met for any reason whatsoever. In such cases, the planned partial exemptions will not be recognised, without this giving rise to any right to compensation and/or indemnity whatsoever.

POLI.design reserves the right not to assign all partial exemptions should not enough candidates meet the appropriate requirements.
